A new Oil & Gas law has been one of the top five legislative targets for the Indonesian Parliament for at least 5 years. The Indonesia Petroleum Association (IPA) has recently received a draft of the "new" Oil & Gas law prepared by the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources, however a formal draft is yet to be approved by the President and tabled to the Parliament. In this session, we will give an overview of a number of the key initiatives of the draft and discuss what this might mean for the industry, existing projects/arrangements and transactions in the future.
