The Ministry of Trade, Agribusiness and Industry is the lead institution planning Ghana's participation in Expo 2025 Osaka.

Ghana is participating under the sub-theme **"Empowering Lives"** and the specific country theme **"Creating a Country of Possibilities"**.

One of the proposed activities for the participation is the **Ghana Business & Investment Forum** slated for 11th September 2025 which is the main Ghana slated date for the Osaka Expo.

1. Tourism Theme Week

The week will feature topics on: Taste Ghana. The duration for the Tourism week will be from the 1st – 18th May 2025 and the Key Ministry for the Event is the Ministry of Tourism.

2. Health Theme Week

Topics to be featured include:

- (1) Telecommunication – Demonstrating Remote healthcare solutions and AI- driven diagnostics

4. Education Theme Weeks

Topics to be featured include:

- (2) AI – Driven Education solution
- (3) Robotics (Demonstration)
- (4) Vocation Training and skill learning
- (5) STEM Collaboration with GH schools and schools in Tokushima

The duration for the Education Theme Week will be from the 7th July – 3rd August 2025 and the Key Ministry for the Event is the Ministry of Education.

The Playing and Learning Event will be held on the 25th of July 2025 and the key areas of the event include:

- (1) STEM Education,
- (2) AI, Robotics,
- (3) Remote learning,
- (4) Entrepreneurship (TVET).

Key Sectors for the Event include The Ministry of Education, Agencies of the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Communication, Digitalization, Technology and Innovation (MoCDTI).

5. Trade, Investment and Industrial Transformation theme Week
